OSCE confirms Karabakh, Azerbaijan observing ceasefire

Inspectors of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) have confirmed that the troops of the Armenian exclave of Karabakh and the Azerbaijani Armed Forces observe the terms of ceasefire along the northern disengagement line and at the Omar mountain pass, officials in the self-proclaimed Nagorno-Karabakh Republic said Tuesday.

Surveillance from the positions of the Karabakh Defense Army was done by a group of experts with Andjei Caspchik, a personal envoy of the OSCE President, at the head. His two field assistants were Gennady Korzh of Ukraine and Jurgen Schmidt of Germany. The group observing positions from the Azerbaijani side included field assistants Imre Palatinus of Hungary, Karel Kratki of the Czech Republic, and Kenneth Pickels of the UK.
