Bosnia: War-Crimes Witness Found Dead

Prosecutors at the war crimes tribunal in The Hague are seeking information about the apparent suicide of a crucial witness, Stevan Todorovic, 49, a former wartime police chief in Bosnia, who was found over the weekend at his home with a gunshot wound to his temple and a pistol in his hand. This is the second death of a top witness this year. Milan Babic, a former prime minister, hanged himself in his cell in The Hague in March. Both men were to testify at the trial of two former heads of the Serbian security service.
