

Serbia: Foul Play Ruled Out in Milosevic's Death

In the most detailed investigation yet of the illness and death of [Slobodan Milosevic](#), the former president of [Serbia](#), the war crimes tribunal in The Hague said in a report that no evidence of foul play or suicide was found but that during his trial Mr. Milosevic took serious risks with his own health by not taking all prescribed drugs, taking other medicines of his own and repeatedly refusing treatment, tests and even hospitalization. The 42-page report was prepared by the tribunal judge, Kevin Parker, from Australia.
