

Bodies of Muslims Exhumed

ZVORNIK, Bosnia -- Nearly 100 bodies of Bosnian Muslims, most of them in the black plastic body bags of the former Yugoslav army, have been exhumed from several mass graves near this eastern town, forensic officials said.

They said remains found in the last two weeks around an old Muslim graveyard belong mostly to Muslims from Zvornik, 1,300 of whom disappeared when Serb paramilitaries and the former Yugoslav army captured the town at the outbreak of Bosnia's war.

Slobodan Milosevic, the former Serbian and Yugoslav president, who is on trial at the U.N. war crimes court, fugitive Bosnian Serb wartime leader Radovan Karadzic and several other senior Serb officials have been indicted for war crimes in Zvornik.
