

Nigeria: Police Detonate IEDs in Kano

Kano — Kano State police command yesterday said it detonated four high caliber improvised explosive devices (IEDs) planted at Rijiyar Zaki area of Kano metropolis.

The explosives were found near Janbolo area, where the police said they killed four people trying to detonate bombs.

The explosives were discovered inside a handbag by the road side in the area around 9:55am, following which the police were alerted, Daily Trust learnt. Before the detonation, special announcements were continuously aired on local radios to that effect.

An IED had earlier been detonated by the police on Tuesday at the premises of Federal College of Education in Kano.
