## **World Briefing | Africa: Rwanda: Tribunal's Defense Lawyers Strike**

Lawyers defending suspects facing charges in the 1994 genocide in Rwanda began a three-day strike. The lawyers said they backed a list of defendant demands, including rights to bail, to subpoena defense witnesses, and to know the identity of prosecution witnesses sometimes protected by the international court, based in Tanzania.
