Murambatsvina victims dumped in forest

Victims of the government operation Murambatsvinapreviously held at the Helensvale Transit camp in Bulawayo have been forciblymoved again and dumped in a forest near Tsholotsho. Eye witnesses saythey saw police trucks dumping people by the roadside in Kunzi an area near thehome of former Information Minister and MP, Jonathan Moyo. Others weredumped in surrounding commercial farms and another group at the TsholotshoBusiness centre.

The families were initially evicted from Kilarney Squattercamp before being taken in by several churches in the city. Police riotsquads then raided the church halls they were living in last week and forcedthem off to the Helensvale transit camp. Two clergymen were also arrested the melee before being released. Our correspondent Themba Nkosi saysthe latest wave of forced removalsgoes against statements by the District Administrator for Umguza, Punzani Ncubewho said they would be carefully screened over a 30 day period and their original districts determined.

This has not been the case and police details whosupervised the dumping process told the families to find their own way home.
