Free-Zim Youths Embarrass Zuma during Her London Public Address

South Africa's foreign affairs minister Dr. Nkosazana Dlamini Zuma had a night to forget in central London on Wednesday. Pressure group Free-Zim Youth UK made sure they expressed their displeasure with her government's handling of the Zimbabwean crisis. Dr Zuma was addressing students at the London School of Economics on United Nations reforms following her country's election to a non-permanent seat on the Security Council. The youths repeatedly disrupted her lecture with chants of "ANC betrays black Zimbabwe."
